IN THE 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION. **DEMOCRATS & REPUBLICANS** ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN A PRIMARY ELECTION.

WE DO NOT HAVE ANY NON-PARTISAN RACES ON THE PRIMARY BALLOT.

LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE WAS APRIL 22, 2024! THE DEADLINE TO CHANGE YOUR PARTY AFFILIATION WAS

DECEMBER 31, 2023.

IF YOU CHANGED YOUR AFFILIATION AFTER THAT DATE YOU ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO VOTE IN THE 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION.

Voter Process for All In-Person Voting: (Election Day, Early Voting and Excused Absentee)

- Bring your required Identification.
- · Have your ID ready, Driver's Licenses are the most efficient method to scan.
- Election Officers verify your identity and you will be issued a paper ballot, voters with disabilities may use an ADA ballot marking device which prints a paper ballot to be scanned.
- You will mark your ballot and cast your vote!

Voter Requirements to be eligible:

HB 564, eligible voters must meet one of the requirements and not be able on election day or any days of early voting.

- Student who resides temporarily outside of his/her county
- Voter or voter's spouse who has surgery/hospitalization scheduled during Early voting & Election Day
- Member of the armed forces or their dependent.
- KY voter who is an uniformed. service voter confined to a military base.
- In last trimester of pregnancy
- Voter who temporarily resides outside the state but is still eligible to vote in KY
- Voter who has not be declared mentally disabled by court of competent jurisdiction and due to age, disability or illness.
- · Voter who is employed and scheduled to work including commute time during all no excuse in person voting.
- · Voter who is appointed as an election Officer.

- Make application on the State Board of Elections online portal govote.ky.gov or call 859-824-3321 option 4
- Your ballot will be sent via US Mail
- Follow the instructions completely to ensure your ballot is accepted!
